#### **1. Chairman's Report**

The Village Hall continues to be in good use for the benefit of the community. Pre-school, Tea and Bites, Costock WI and Costock Community Cinema appear amongst the many regular bookings as well as bookings for parties and family gatherings throughout the year. This year we introduced Live and Local events into the mix which has proved very successful, and there are plans to do this again in the future..

Work was undertaken this year to refurbish the toilets, which will benefit all that use the hall. I would like to express my thanks to this year's Committee for their valued support during my first year as Chair.

#### **2. Finance Report**

This has been a better year than last year ending with a £922.83 surplus. Bookings have come close to pre-pandemic levels. The only other item of note is that sundries are high in expenditure terms. This is because the expenditure for Live & Local last Autumn went under 'sundries' whereas the income went under 'bookings'

Refurbishment of toilets is now **COMPLETE**. As **AGREED** with Parish Council, Village Hall contributed towards toilet refurbishment.
